**Chapter Grants:** of up to \$1,000 are available to help chapters provide interesting mathematical experiences for their members, others at their school, and their local community.

**Competition Grants:** of up to \$500 per active chapter are available to help pay entrance fees or expenses associated with a math competition in which the chapter members wish to compete.

**Classroom Teaching Grants:** provide up to \$1,500 to reimburse expenses for classroom mathematics materials or mathematics professional memberships for new mathematics teachers in their first, second, or third year in a mathematics teaching job. Applicants must have been a Mu Alpha Theta member.

**Summer Grants:** of up to \$2,000 are available for members attending a summer math program
